
Aims

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

About the course

The WHO Reproductive Health Library (RHL) is used in this eLearning course as the main resource on Evidence Based Medicine. (http://www.who.int/rhl)

RHL is an electronic review journal on Evidence-Based Medicine (EBM), initiated in 1997 and published by the Department of Reproductive Health and Research at WHO Headquarters in Geneva, Switzerland. RHL takes the best available evidence on sexual and reproductive health mainly from Cochrane systematic reviews and presents it as practical actions for clinicians (and policy-makers) to improve health outcomes, especially in developing countries.

Who is the course designed for?

The course is aimed at health care workers, medical doctors (OBGYN), nurses, midwifes, teaching institutions and universities around the world as well as for Technical Officers working in related areas of reproductive health, Programme Officers, Senior Managers, National Programme Officers etc.

What will participants learn?

The course aims to enable you to identify and use evidence-based practices for sexual and reproductive health care in under-resourced settings.
