





Announcement Young Researcher Paper Award "Paolo Rossi"

Alleanza Cefalalgici-CIRNA Foundation Onlus under the auspices of the Headache Science & Neurorehabilitation Center (IRCCS C. Mondino Foundation-University of Pavia) and the European Headache and Migraine Alliance (EMHA) has established an investigator paper award to be presented at the International Congress "From Research to Headache Care and Back", Pavia, 1st-2nd October 2021

The award consists in a prize of 2,000 EUR.

The prize is named in honor of Paolo Rossi.

Dr. Paolo Rossi was Chief of the Headache Clinic at INI Grottaferrata (Rome), Head of Clinical Neurology at the Nursing School at Tor Vergata University and Member of EMHA Board.

He was greatly appreciated for his interesting and innovative research in the field of clinical and neurophysiological aspects of headache. He passionately and tirelessly worked in favour of the headache patients Associations at national and international level.

Purpose

The Young Researcher Award is presented for the best paper in the field of neurophysiology of headache published in a peer-reviewed scientific journal.

Eligibility

- Applicants must be under 40 years of age. A copy of ID indicating the date of birth is to be submitted along with the CV;
- Be a physician admitted to a PhD course or who has received his/her PhD degree no more than 3 years before the submission date;
- Co-authorship is acceptable provided that the Young Researcher applicant is

the first author:

- Full-length original research paper published in international peer-reviewed scientific journals in the field of headache in the last two years.

The Awardee will be asked to attend the hybrid Congress planned in Pavia and give a presentation of his/her paper at the Congress.

Applications must include:

- A letter from the applicant stating his/her interest in the competition.
- A current curriculum vitae
- ID indicating the date of birth
- A copy of a document attesting the status of the participant related to the PhD School/degree.

Deadline for receipt of applications: 15th september 2021

An **international Expert Committee** will review eligible papers and will make final decision about the award by 25th September.
